

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATE

1. Make sure that the Admit Card is not detached from the application form while depositing the application form. Admission Cards are to be collected from **8th November to 12th November, 2010** from the Superintendent/Head of concerned School (Examination Centre) at the distt. level.
2. Reach the Examination Centre atleast half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. DO NOT take **calculator, mathematical physical table, mobile or any other kind of ready reckoner** to the examination hall.
4. **The examination will be conducted in one session at 10.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. consisting of two parts (i) & (ii)**
  - (i) **Mental Ability Test (MAT) consisting of 90 compulsory multiple choice questions.**
  - (ii) **Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 compulsory multiple choice questions.**
5. Time for Examination is 3 hours. Children with disability will be given 30 minutes extra.
6. Each question carries 1 (one) mark. No negative marking.
7. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admission Card, on the Answer Sheet.
8. DO NOT write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the Answer Sheet.
9. All questions in the booklet are objective type. For each question FOUR possible answers are given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet as per instructions given in the Answer Sheet.
10. **Record your answer-using PEN only.** You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet as advised.
11. During the Examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
12. **Hand over your Question booklet, Answer sheet and Admission Card to the invigilator before you leave the Examination Hall.**
13. **Candidate belonging to SC/BC Category has to attach the attested copy of the certificate regarding reserved caste issued by SDM/Tehsildar with the Application Form.**
14. **Candidate belonging to Physically Challenged Group of Children must attach the attested copy of certificate issued by the competent authority stating that the child suffers from 40% or more disability as per the P.W.D. Act 1995 disability is of permanent/temporary nature.**
15. **Income certificate/Affidavit regarding income of parents not exceeding Rs. 1,50,000/- (by all means) must be attached with application form.**
16. **Application form should be submitted to the concerned Distt. Centre written below. No form/request will be entertained at S.C.E.R.T./S.I.S.E., Punjab, Chandigarh.**
