

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATE
(For the Students Studying in Class VIII)

1. Make sure that the Admit Card is not detached from the application form. Admit Cards will be sent to the chief superintendent/Head of concerned school (examination centre) after allotting the Roll Numbers. Candidate can collect the Admit Card from the superintendent of the examination centre at least one week before the examination.
2. Reach the Examination Centre atleast half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. DO NOT take **calculator, mathematical physical table, mobile or any other kind of ready reckoner** to the examination hall.
4. **The examination will be conducted in one sessions only from 10.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M.**
5. **Examination will have TWO PARTS.**
 - (i) **Part I: Part I is confined to Mental Ability Test (MAT) consisting of 90 compulsory questions.**
 - (ii) **Part II : Part II is confined to Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 compulsory questions, 35 from Science, 35 from Social Studies and 20 from Mathematics.**
6. **Time for examination will be 3 hours only.**
7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
8. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the Answer Sheet and on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
9. DO NOT write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the Answer Sheet.
10. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each question FOUR possible answers are given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.
11. Record your answer-using PEN only. You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet as advised by the State.
12. During the Examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
13. Hand over your Question booklet and Answer sheet to the invigilator before you leave the examination hall.
14. Hand over the admission card to the Invigilator before you leave the examination hall.
15. Application Form should be submitted to the concerned Distt. Centre (written below). No Form/request will be entertained at state level office i.e. S.I.S.E. Punjab, Chandigarh.
16. SC/ST/Disable Candidate must attach the category certificate issued from competent authority along with the application form.
