INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATE
(For the Students Studying in Class X)

1. Make sure that the Admit Card is not detached from the Application Form while depositing the Application Form. Candidate must collect the Admit Card from the Chief Superintendent of the Examination Centre one week before the examination.
2. Reach the Examination Centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. DO NOT take calculator, mathematical & physical table, mobile phone or any other kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. The examination will be conducted in one session only on the same day from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm.
5. The examination will have two parts ;
 - (i) Part I : Part I is confined to Mental Ability Test (MAT) consisting of 90 compulsory multiple choice questions
 - (ii) Part II : Part II is confined to Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 compulsory multiple choice questions, 35 from Science, 35 from Social Science and 20 from Mathematics.
6. Time for examination will be three hours only. Candidates with disability will be given 30 minutes extra time.
7. Each question will carry 1 (one) mark. There will be no negative marking.
8. Write your Roll Number, as given in the admit card, on the Answer Sheet.
9. DO NOT Write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the Answer Sheet.
10. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each question FOUR possible answers will given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.
11. Record your answer using PEN only. You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet.
12. During the Examination follow the instructions of the invigilator strictly.
13. Hand over your Question booklet and Answer sheet to the Invigilator before you leave the examination hall.
14. Hand over the Admit card to the Invigilator before leaving the examination hall.
15. **Application Form should be submitted at the concerned District Centre (Written below). No Form/request will be entertained at the State Level i.e. S.I.S.E. Pb. Chandigarh.**
16. SC/BC/Disabled Candidate must attach the category certificate issued from competent authority along with the Application form. No form will be entertained without category certificate.
17. Candidate belonging to Physically Challenged Group of Children must attach the attested copy of certificate issued by the competent authority stating that the child offers from 40% or more disability as per P.W.D. Act of 1995 disability and the disability to or permanent/temporary nature.
