- c) Student obtaining benefits under this scheme will not be allowed to avail of any other benefit under any other scheme for pursuing the same course.
- d) Scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family
- e) Parents/Guardians and the students should be domicile of Punjab State.
- f) Student should be regular in attendance.

Applications are invited from students belonging to minority communities (Sikh, Muslims, Christians, Buddhists & Parsis) pursuing studies in India in Govt. of Private Senior Secondary School/College/University including residential institute, Polytechnic, ITI/Industrial Training Centre affiliated with NCVT, for awarding scholarship under Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme for the academic session 2012-13 for new & renewal cases

Eligibility Criteria/Conditions for Scholarship

- i) Scholarship is to be awarded to the student who have secured not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination.
- ii) Scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family.
- iii) Annual income of the parents or guardian of the student should not exceed Rs. 2.00 lacs from all sources.
- iv) A scholarship holder under this scheme will not avail any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the course.
- v) The student should be resident of Punjab State.
- vi) The student should be regular in attendance.
- vii) Continuation (Renewal) of the scholarship will be paid to those students who secure not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination.

Mode of Apply

- a) **Procedure to apply Online -**
 - i) The eligible students will online on the website www.momascholarship.gov.in. Students will forward their applications online to the institution and will take a printout of the same. this print out along with all other necessary/requisite documents (as directed in the print out) will be submitted to their concerned institutions while applying online. Student will get a temporary ID, which he/she will retain/keep with him/her for any further correspondence etc.
 - ii) The institution then will approved all these applications online by login in on the same website with the User ID and Password (provided to them earlier by Welfare Department).
- b) **Procedure to apply for Senior Secondary Schools (+1, +2)**
 The Demand will be prepared by the Head of the concerned school for further submission to **District Education Officer**, in the shape of **Hard and Soft Copies**. The concerned district Education Officer will consolidate the demand of all schools and forward in the shape of **hard & soft copies in the single lot to the Director, Welfare of Schedule Castes, Backward Classes & Minorities, Punjab, SCO No. 128-129, Sector 34-A, Chandigarh in the following format latest by 20th October, 2012**
