National Level Examination will be conducted by N.C.E.R.T. New Delhi on 11 May 2014. Students studying in 10th class in State Govt. Kendriya Vidyalayas, Navodaya Vidyalayas or any other type of recognized/affiliated schools situated in Punjab securing minimum 70% marks for general category and 55% marks for SC/ST/Physically challenged students in 9th class annual examination are eligible.

Duration of examination will be of three hours. There will be one question paper consisting of two parts (1) Mental Ability Test (MAT)=50 marks and (11) Scholastic Aptitude Test =130 (Aptitude Test=90 marks + Language Comprehensive Test English=40 marks). Under SAT there are ██████ subjects:-



The medium of examination shall be Punjabi/ English.

ADMISSION FORMS:- Admission forms can be downloaded from the Punjab Govt. Website www.ssapunjab.org. The Admission forms duly filled in and complete in all respects should reach the Principal of the school (centre) as given in the admission form by 15-09-2013 where examination centre in the concerned District is situated . **No forms/request will be entertained at the State Institute of Science Education, Punjab, Chandigarh.**

RESERVATION :- As per National reservation Norms there will be 15% reservation for SC, 7.5% ST and 3% reservation for Physically challenged Group of Candidates i.e. 1%for each group namely hearing, Physically and visually challenged group of students irrespective of caste category (General , SC,ST). It is necessary for the candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Category to attach the attested copy of the Certificate regarding reserved caste issued by SDM/Tehsildar with the admission form. There will be candidates belonging to physically challenged group of children must attach the attested copy of certificate issued by the competent authority stating that the child suffer from the 40% or more as per the P.W.D. Act, 1995 disability and that the disability is of permanent/temporary nature, The candidate will be considered in general category if the above mentioned certificate does not reach up till 15-09-2013 attached with the admission form. **No admission fee is charged for this examination.**

Note:- The NTSE Awardees of class VIII are not required to appear in class X NTSE Examination again. However the unsuccessful candidates of class VIII can now again appear for class X NTS Examination.

 - (i) Part I: Part I is confined to Mental Ability Test (MAT) consisting of 50 Marks questions.
 - (ii) Part II : Part II is confined to Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 compulsory questions, 35 from Science, 35 from Social Studies and 20 from Mathematics and 40 questions from English Language (Comprehensive Type).
6. Time for examination will be 3 hours only.
7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
8. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the Answer Sheet and on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
9. DO NOT write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the Answer Sheet.
10. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each question FOUR possible answers are given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.
11. Record your answer-using Ball Point (Blue or Black)PEN only. You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet as advised by the State.
12. During the Examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
