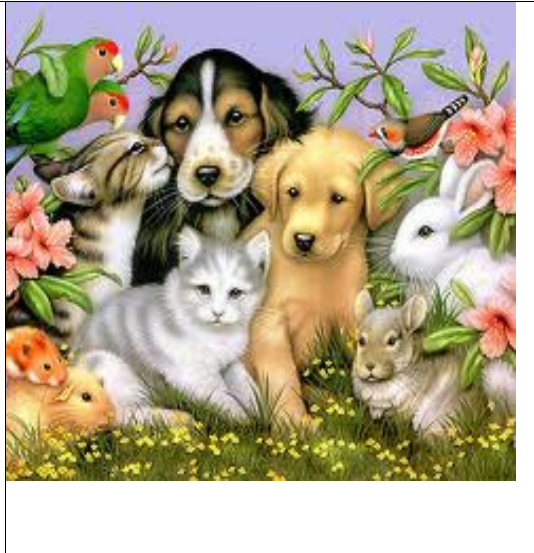

2.	<p>Reading aloud by the teacher. Reading aloud by the students. The teacher will explain the 2<sup>nd</sup> stanza to the students. The teacher will make the students read the 1st line of the 2<sup>nd</sup> stanza than asks the questions to the students.
