## INDIAN NAVY AN OCEAN OF OPPORTUNITIES

1. Applications are invited from **UNMARRIED MALE CANDIDATES** (fulfilling the conditions of nationality as laid down by the Govt of India) to join the prestigious Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala under the 10+2 (B Tech) Cadet Entry Scheme.

### ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

2. **Age** 17 to 19½ years (i.e. born between 02 Jul 1996 & 01 Jan 1999 (both dates inclusive).
3. **Educational Qualification**. Passed Senior Secondary Examination (10+2 Pattern) or its equivalent from University/Board with at least 70% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) and at least 50% marks in English (either in Class X or Class XII).
4. **Physical Standards.**
  - (a) **Height and Weight**. Minimum height - 157 cms with correlated weight as per age.
  - (b) **Eye Sight**. The minimum acceptable vision standards for distant vision is 6/6, 6/9 correctable to 6/6, 6/6 with glasses. Should not be colour/night blind.
  - (c) **Tattoo**. Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist end and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

**Note** - There will be no relaxation in physical standards.

### THE NAVY OFFERS YOU

6. On successful completion of training you will be commissioned as Sub Lieutenant. The benefits of being an officer in the Navy are enumerated in succeeding paragraphs.
6. **Pay Scale & Promotions**. The promotion from Sub Lieutenant to Commander is on time scale basis and thereafter on selection basis subject to fulfillment of

### SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 13 (a) Candidates will be issued call up for Services Selection Board (SSB) based on their performance in Senior Secondary Education (10+2 equivalent). Integrated Headquarters, Ministry of Defence (Navy) reserves the right to shortlist applications and to fix cut off percentage. No communication will be entertained on this account. SSB interviews for short listed candidates will be scheduled at Bangalore/Bhopal/Coimbatore/Visakhapatnam during Aug-Nov 15.
- (b) Shortlisted candidates will be informed about their selection for SSB interview on their E-mail or through SMS (provided by candidate in their application form).
- (c) SSB interview will be conducted in two Stages. Stage I test consists of intelligence test, Picture Perception and Discussion test. Candidates who fail to qualify in Stage I will be routed back on the same day. Stage II tests comprises Psychological testing, Group testing and Interview which will last for 04 days. Successful candidates will thereafter undergo Medical Examination (approx duration 01-05 days).
- (d) Candidates recommended by the SSBs and declared medically fit, will be selected for training in the order of an All India Merit List depending on the number of vacancies.
- (e) Change of SSB venue for interview is not permissible.
- (f) Any correspondence regarding change of SSB date is to be addressed to the Callup Officer of the concerned SSB on receipt of call up letter. Award of fresh dates for SSB would be subject to availability.
- (g) No compensation will be paid in respect of any injury sustained as a result of tests.
- (h) Return 3<sup>rd</sup> AC rail fare is admissible for the SSB interview, if appearing for the first time for this entry.

### TRAINING

14. The training is scheduled to commence in Jan 2016.
15. Selected Candidates will be inducted as Cadets for four year B Tech course in Electronics & Communication or Mechanical Engineering at the Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala. During the course, Cadets will be allotted Executive or Engineering including Naval Architect specialisation of Electrical Branch. On completion of the course, B Tech Degree will be awarded by Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU).

8. **Cost to Company (CTC)**. The CTC for a Sub Lieutenant would be approximately Rs. 74,100/- per month. This includes Basic Pay, DA, Grade Pay, Military Service Pay, House Rent Allowance, Transport allowance and Kit maintenance allowance. These rates are not statutory and are subject to change.

9. **Privileges**. In addition to the CTC mentioned above, Navy provides Free medical facilities for self & dependents, Canteen facilities, entitled rations, Mess/Club/Sports Facilities, Furnished Govt. Accommodation, Car/Housing Loan at subsidised rates.

10. **Group Insurance & Gratuity**. Insurance cover of Rs. 10 Lakhs (own contribution) and Gratuity will be granted to the officer as per the latest rules in force.

11. **Leave Entitlements**. Officers are entitled to 60 days annual and 29 days casual leave every year (subject to service exigencies). They are also entitled 40% rail concession to any place and free travel (as per extant rules) for self and dependents. Leave during training period will be as per the Training Policy in force.

12. **Sports & Adventure**. The Navy provides facilities to pursue any sport of your liking. In addition, one can learn and participate in adventure sports, such as river rafting, mountaineering, hot air ballooning, hand gliding, wind surfing etc.

Note:- **The entire cost of training, including books and reading material, will be borne by the Indian Navy. The cadets will also be provided with free clothing and messing.**

#### HOW TO APPLY

16. Candidates are to fill in 'e-application' (Online) for this entry. The candidates are to apply online (e-application) from 23 May 15. The online application registration will cease on 12 Jun 15. The procedure for applying online is explained in Paras 17 & 18 below.

**IMPORTANT** - Please read the instructions given on the website carefully before submitting your 'e-application' form.

17. **Online (e-application)**:- Whilst filling up the e-application, it is advisable to keep the relevant documents readily available to enable the following:-

- Correct filling up of personal particulars. Details are to be filled up as given in the Matriculation Certificate.
- Fields such as e-mail address, mobile number are mandatory fields and need to be filled.
- Candidates are required to upload recent passport size digital photograph of size less than 25 kb (.jpeg or .jpg format).

18. **Filling up of e-application** - For filling up application Online visit our website [www.joinindiannavy.gov.in](http://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in) and proceed as follows:-

- Click on the apply online 'Officer Entry' button on the Home Page.
- Fill the online registration form. Tips to assist in filling up fields have been provided as you highlight each field.
- After filling the form, click on Preview and check if all the information entered by you is correct.
- Before clicking the Print Application button it should be checked whether all the details entered in the form are correct as you will not be able to make any corrections after saving the record. Candidates can take the print of the application form by entering the relevant details.
- Print two copies of the online Application Form having the system generated Application Number. One copy of this Application Form is to be duly signed and mailed (posted) to Post Box No. 04, Nirman Bhawan PO, New Delhi - 110 011 along with the following documents:- Self attested photo copies of 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> class certificates along with Mark Sheets, other educational certificates and photographs. Application to be sent by ordinary post only. Speed post/courier and Registered post will not be accepted.
