ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- 2. Age. 17 to 191/2 years (i.e. born between 02 Jul 1996 & 01 Jan 1999 (both dates inclusive).
- Educational Qualification. Passed Senior Secondary Examination (10+2 Pattern) or its equivalent from University/Board with at least 76% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) and at least 50% marks in English (either in Class X or Class XII).

4. Physical Standards.

- (a) tieight and Weight. Minimum height 157 cms with correlated weight as per age.
- (b) <u>Eve Sight</u>. The minimum acceptable vision standards for distant vision is **6/6**, **6/9** correctable to **6/6**, **6/6** with glasses. Should not be colour/night blind.
- (c) Tattoo. Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist end and on the reverse side of palim/back (dorsel) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidat s will be barred from further selection.

Note - There will be no relaxation in physical standards.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 13.6a) Candidates will be issued call up for Services Selection Board (SSB) based on their performance in Senior Secondary Education (10+2 inquivalent). Integrated freedquarters, Ministry of Defence (Navy) reserves the right to shortlist applications and to fix cut off percentage. No communication will be entertained on this arcount. SSB interviews for short listed candidates will be scheduled at Baregalone/Biopal/Coimbatore/Visakhapatnam during Aug-Nov 15.
- (b) Shortested candiates will be informed about their selection for SSB interview on their E-mail or thorugh SMS(provided by carrelidate in their application form).
- (c) SSB interview will be conducted in two Stages. Stage I test consists of intelligence test. Picture Perception and Discussion test. Candidates who fall to qualify in Stage I will be routed back on the same day. Stage II tests comprises: Psychological testing. Group testing and Interview which will last for 04 days. Successful candidates will thereafter undergo Medical Examination (approx duration @3-05 days).
- (d) Caendidates recommended by the SSBs and declared medically fit, will be selected for training in the order of an All India Merit List depending on the number of vacencies.
- (e) Change of SSB venue for interview is not permissible.
- (f) Any correspondence regarding change of SSB date is to be addressed to the Castup Officer of the concerned SSB on receipt of call up letter. Award of fresh dates for SSB would be subject to availability.
- (g) No compensation will be paid in respect of any injury sustained as a result of tests.
- (h) Return 3" AC rail fare is admissible for the SSB interview, if appearing for the first time for this entry.

TRAINING

- The training is scheduled to commence in Jan 2016.
- 15. Selected Candidates will be inducted as Cadets for four year B Tech course in Electronics & Communication or Mechanical Engineering at the Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala. During the course, Cadets with be allotted Executive or Engineering Including Naval Architect specialisation of Electrical Branch. On completion of the course, B fedh Degree will be awarded by Jawaharial Nehru University (JNU).
