Online applications are invited for direct recruitment from Indian nationals at above said Punjab Police Website to fill up the vacancies of male constables in the Special Security Group (Special Protection Unit) in Armed Police Cadre, of Punjab Police, in the Pay Band of Rs. 10300-34800 + Grade Pay Rs. 3200/-, and other allowances as admissible.

However, as per State Government instructions (No. 7/204/2012-4FP1/66 dated 15.01.2015), during the probation period, they will only be eligible for fixed emoluments, i.e. equivalent to the minimum of the Pay band. During the probation period, they would not be entitled to any grade pay, annual increments or any other allowances, except TA. As per Punjab Cabinet decision (30.4.2016), the probation period of all fresh appointees would be 3 years.

1. ONLINE APPLICATION FORM (OAF)

The online application form can be filled from 9:00 a.m. 08.10.2016 till 11:59 p.m. on 28.10.2016 online at above said Punjab Police Website. Candidates are advised to apply online well-in-advance without waiting for the last date of submission of Online Application Form (OAF). It is made clear that no offline Application form or copy of downloaded Application form will be accepted or acted upon at Recruitment Centre or other Police office.

The candidates are advised to submit **ONLY SINGLE ONLINE APPLICATION** for the post of Constable in SSG(SPU). However, if somehow, the candidate manages to submit multiple online applications, only his first application and fee paid shall be entertained. More than one application from same candidate shall not be entertained and the fee paid not be reimbursed.

4. ESSENTIAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES

A. NATIONALITY The applicant/candidate-must be a citizen of India. He should not have obtained the citizenship/ permanent residency/green card of any other country.

B. AGE

- The minimum age (as on 1st January of the year in which the advertisement is published) for recruitment at the rank of constable should be 18 years and maximum age should be 28 years. For Ex-Serviceman and candidates belonging to SC/ST & BC Category, the age relaxation as per rules shall be made available (for details, see full advertisement on Punjab Police Website i.e. www.punjabpolice recruitment.in).

C. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- The minimum educational qualifications shall be 10+2 or its equivalent from a recognized Education Board/University, and the candidate must have passed Matriculation examination with Punjabi as one of the compulsory or elective subjects or any other equivalent examination in Punjabi language. (for details, see full advertisement on Punjab Police Website i.e. www.punjabpolice recruitment.in).

D. PHYSICAL STANDARDS — HEIGHT AND CHEST

Candidates (except Ex-Serviceman)	
Minimum Height required	5'-10" (5 feet 10 inches)
Minimum Chest required	Minimum 38" (38 inches) (with minimum expansion of 2")

For Ex-Serviceman candidates	
Minimum Height required	5'-10" (5 feet 10 inches)

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Note: There is no minimum chest required for Ex-Servicemen.

5. SELECTION PROCESS

The recruitment shall be conducted at the centres as may be decided depending upon the number of applicants. Candidates will be informed about the Recruitment Centre via SMS & email and the details about the centres will also be uploaded on the recruitment website.

The Recruitment Board shall conduct the Substance Abuse (Drug Addiction) Test (SAT), Physical Screening Test (PST) and the Physical measurement Test (PMT) of a candidate shall be conducted on a single day.

(a) SUBSTANCE ABUSE (DRUG ADDICTION) TEST (SAT)

Every candidate will be required to undergo a Substance Abuse (Drug Addiction) Test at the Recruitment Centre before the conduct of the Physical Screening Test (PST) and Physical Measurement Test (PMT). The Test shall be conducted under the supervision of officials of the Health Department/recognized Medical University/Institute. **Only those candidates who clear/pass the Substance Abuse Test shall be eligible for appearing in the PST/PMT.**

(b) PHYSICAL SCREENING TEST (PST)

The candidates who are declared clear in the SAT shall be required to appear in the PST, which shall be of a qualifying nature and shall comprise of the Race, Rope Climbing (un-assisted), Standing Broad Jump for all candidates except Ex-Serviceman. For Ex-Serviceman, the PST shall include Race, Full Squats and Pushups.

NOTE: A candidate must qualify in all the above events. Failure to qualify in any one of the above events of Physical Screening Test shall disqualify the candidate.

(c) PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT TEST (PMT)

Only those candidates who qualify the PST shall be screened for height measurement and chest measurement/expansion.

6. MARKING SYSTEM

The candidates shall be evaluated for a maximum of **30 marks**. These shall comprise of marks for Height (up to maximum of 15 marks), for Educational Qualification (up to maximum of 10 marks) and Additional Marks (up to maximum of 2 marks) and Interview-cum-Personality Test (up to 3 marks).

7. INTERVIEW-CUM-PERSONALITY TEST (03 Marks)

From amongst the candidates who qualify the SAT, Physical Screening Test and Physical Measurement Test, the Chairman Recruitment Board will draw up a **Preliminary Merit List**, on the basis of the Marks obtained by the candidates in the **Height measurement** (15 marks), **Educational Qualification** (10 marks) and **Additional Marks** as given above (02 marks). The total score will be out of maximum 27 marks.

On the basis of **Preliminary Merit List**, The Central Recruitment Board shall select candidates for Interview-cum-Personality Test. The number of candidates to be called for interview **would be approximately three times** the total number of vacancies marked for each category (for details, see full advertisement on Punjab Police Website i.e. www.punjabpolice recruitment.in).

The Application Form Fee once deposited shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

11. PROVISION SELECTION

The selection in the Recruitment Process shall be absolutely provisional, and it shall be subject to the following mandatory clearances:

12. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Before their enlistment in the Police, the candidates shall have to be medically examined and certified physically fit for service by the Civil Surgeon/Medical Board constituted for this purpose.

13. VERIFICATION OF CHARACTER AND ANTECEDENTS

The selection of the candidate shall be subject to the verification of his antecedents, and if anything adverse is found against the candidate during the verification, his candidature shall be summarily rejected and no claim, whatsoever, shall be entertained.

Burden of Proof of originality of educational documents or any certificates submitted shall be on candidate. Any document found false or fabricated will attract disqualification from recruitment process and at any stage of service would result in strict administrative and/or penal action.

14. PERIOD OF PROBATION

The selected constables will be put on Probation, which will be of the duration as specified in the Punjab Police Act, 2007, Punjab Police Rules 1934 and the State Government instructions issued from time to time.
