This is with reference to your letter dated 24th August 2016 marked to Director (VP) with memo no. RSSS/2016/1089 regarding establishment of Science, Mathematics and Technology clubs for children under Rashtriya Avishkaar Abhiyaan (RAA) during 2016-17. In regards to this I would like to inform you that as such there are no specific categories of clubs established by Vigyan Prasar (VP). However you will be happy to know that VP runs a network of science club called VIPNET. This network is established to weave all science clubs, societies, organizations who are working in the field of science and are willing to work with Vigyan Prasar.

Any individual, group of children, school, organization etc. can seek affiliation to VIPNET by filling the affiliation form available on our website. After receiving the affiliation form a unique id will be provided to a particular club and the affiliation certificate will be dispatched to the club. VP does not charge any registration fee from the clubs. To guide, to direct and to define road map on performing science activities at the respective clubs VP runs a monthly newsletter cum magazine called VIPNET News (presently on hold due to administrative issue) which includes activity based articles and club reports which will help clubs to do better in STEM at school level. The clubs needs to carry out the work by their own and report us on regular basis. Based on the reporting by a particular club VP provides certain facilities to a club. To begin with each registered club will be put in a white club category. Based on the reporting frequency of a club a review will be done at the end of each year. After the review a club may be upgraded, degraded or will remain in the same category as previous. The category of a club will decide the facilities provided to a club. All the details regarding the formation and categorization of club are briefly described in the brochure attached with this letter.

Further if needed VP can consider to organize an orientation programme / workshop for the selected schools of Punjab in support with the SCERT so that schools have a clear idea about the VIPNET.

We look forward to have further communication on the same.

How to form a new science club and join VIPNET?

Any youth / adult with a group of children can discuss the formation of a science club with friends and people in the area he / she resides in. At least 10 members should join together to form a club. The proposed name of the club has to be provided in the VIPNET membership form. Affiliation would be conferred after completion of necessary procedures.

Guidelines for each registered club:

- ✓ VIPNET logo with club ID must be used in each activity.
- √ VIPNET logo and club ID must be clearly visible in the photographs of the programmes, events and workshops conducted by the club.
- ✓ Activity report must be submitted in the format provided on the website and/or placed in the brochure.
- Report can be submitted through e-mails, post, online or by hand. Report must be supplemented with photographs of the programme. Reports without photographs will not be considered as proper reports.
- ✓ Mere participation of a club member in any workshop, programme etc will not be considered as a part of report.
- \checkmark I-cards provided will be valid for one year only.
- √ Vigyan Prasar reserves the right to change, update or cancel the facility provided to the clubs as demanded by circumstances.

Category of Clubs:

A system of categorization of clubs has been developed to encourage science activities in the club and keep their morale high. The highlights of the process are:

- > Clube will be divided into five categories.
- > Categories will be represented by respective names.
- > Based on the frequency of reports, clube will be promoted or downgraded to various categories.

- Review meeting for status change will be performed in the last week of December each year.






3. SILVERCLUB:






5. PLATINUM CLUB:
