REVISION OF INCOME SLAB FOR GRANT OF SCHOLARSHIP


1. Please refer to Sainik School Kapurthala letter No SSKP/467/OSVIP dated 02 Mar 2021 addressed to Principal Secretary Department of School Education and copy endorsed to you, photocopy enclosed for ready reference.
2. The number of students eligible for the State Govt Scholarship has reduced drastically post implementation of Pay Commissions of Central and State Govt. This adversely affects the input as middle income group never falls in the criteria. Therefore, it needs revision.
3. The existing scheme of granting scholarship for students from Punjab is as under:-

Annual income	Amt of Scholarship (Rs)
Up to Rs 96,000/-	26,000/-
96,001/- to 1,20,000/-	19,500/-
1,20,001/- to 1,44,000/-	13,000/-
1,44,001/- to 1,80,000/-	7,500/-
From Rs 1,80,001/- to Rs 2,70,000/-	No scholarship

4. During the XXI meeting of the Board of Governors, Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence held on 15 Mar 18 at New Delhi, the Board has recommended a uniform scale of scholarship across all States of India. The proposed scheme is as under: -

Annual income	% of Tuition fee payable (Present tuition fee Rs 79,860/- per annum)
Up to Rs 3.00 lac	100%
3,00,001 – 5,00,000	75%
5,00,001 – 7,50,000	50%
7,50,001 – 10,00,000	25%
More than Rs 10.00 lac	Nil

5. Scholarships pertaining to this school are dealt by OSD (Scholarship) at the office of Director Public Instructions (S) Punjab. Therefore, it is requested that suitable directions through proper channel be issued to the concerned department for revision of scholarship scheme which will attract brilliant students who cannot afford the fees at the present level and provide a better educational opportunity to the candidates with weaker economic background.

Dear Sir,

1. Sainik Schools are run jointly by the State Govt and Ministry of Defence. Min of Defence besides handling all policy matters, also provides service personnel for the School including three services officers (Principal, Vice Principal and Adm Officer), allocates various grants to the Schools including scholarships for the wards of defence personnel and subsidy to all cadets to Sainik Schools. Responsibilities of State Govt. include creation and maintenance of the entire infrastructure for the Schools, give regular Grants-in-aid to the School for various requirements and provide scholarships to the students belonging to the State.

2. For administrative support Sainik Schools are dependent on state administration. A substantial scholarship by the state Govt to the children belonging to the state helps in attracting deserving candidates to the Sainik Schools which ultimately leads to better representation of the state in the officers' cadre of Armed Forces. At present different states are following different scales of scholarships with few of the states covering less than 10% of total expenditure of the cadets studying in Sainik Schools.

3. In the XXIst meeting of the Board of Governors held on 15 Mar 2018 in New Delhi, Board has recommended a uniform scale of scholarship across all states as under :-

SNo	Income of Parent (per annum)	Scholarship	Type
1.	Up to Rs 3,00,000/-	100 % Tuition Fee	Full Scholarship
2.	Rs 3,00,001/- to Rs 5,00,000/-	75 % Tuition Fee	$\frac{3}{4}$ Scholarship
3.	Rs 5,00,001/- to Rs 7,50,000/-	50 % Tuition Fee	$\frac{1}{2}$ Scholarship
4.	Rs 7,50,001/- to Rs 10,00,000/-	25 % Tuition Fee	$\frac{1}{4}$ Scholarship
5.	More than Rs 10,00,000/-	Nil	No Scholarship

4. You are requested to revise the scholarship rates for the Sainik School students of your state as per above scale.
