The 11th August, 1978

No. G.S.R. 81/Const./Art.309/78.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules regulating the recruitment, and the conditions of service of persons appointed, to the Punjab State Education Class-III (School Cadre) Service, namely:

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab State Education Class III Short title (School Cadre) Service Rules, 1978;

Short title commencement and application.

- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette;
- (3) They shall apply to all posts specified in Appendix 'A' to these rules;
- 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,

Definition s

- (a) 'Board' means the Punjab Subordinate Services Selection Board;
- (b) 'Commission' means the Punjab Public Service Commission;
- (c) 'direct appointment' means an appointment made otherwise than by promotion within the cadre of the Service or by transfer of an official already in the Service of the Government of India or of a
- (d) 'Director' means the Director of Public Instruction, (Schools),
- (e) 'Government' means the Government of the State of Punjab in the Education Department;
- (f) 'recognised University' means --
 - (i) any university incorporated by law in any of the States of India;
 - (ii) In the case of degree, diplomas or certificates obtained as a result of examination held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab, Sind or Dacca University or

Number and character of posts. 3. The Service shall have two branches, namely, Men Branch and Women Branch and shall comprise the posts shown in-Appendix 'A' to these rules:

Provided that nothing in these rules shall affect the inherent right of Government to add to or reduce the number of such posts or to create new posts with different designation and scales of pay whether permanently or temporarily.

Domicile and Charaeter of Candidates.

- 4. (1) No person shall be appointed to the Service, unless he is -
 - (a) a citizen of India; or
 - (b) a citizen of Nepal, or
 - (c) a subject of Bhutan; or
 - (d) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January. 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in India; or
 - (c) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Shri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar) Zambia Malawi, Zaire, and Ethopia, with the intention of permanently settling in India:
 - Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (b), (c), (d) and (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.
- (2) A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may admitted to an examination or inteview conducted by the Commission or Board or other recruiting authority and he may also provisionally be appointed subject to the necessary certificate being given to him by the Government of India.
- (3) No person shall be recruited to the Service by direct appointment, unless he produces a certificate of character from the Principal academic officer of the University college, school or institution last attended, if any, and similar certificates of character from two responsible persons not being his relatives, who are well acquianted with him in his private life and are unconnected with his university, college, school or institution.

Qualifica-

5. (1) No person shall be appionted to any post in the Service, unless hr possesses necessary qualifications and experience as laid down in column 5 of the Appendix 'B' to these rules.

(2) No person shall be recruited to any post in the Service by direct appointment unless he possesses knowledge of Punjabi language of matriculation or ment unless he possesses the test of Punjabi language of Matriculation

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6. No person,—

Disqualification.

- (1) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (2) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the Service

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. (1) No person shall be recruited to the Service by direct appointment if he is less than seventeen years or more than twenty-seven years of age on the date of such appointment or unless he is within such range of minimum and maximum age as may be specifically fixed by Government from time to time:

Age.

Provided that the condition of upper age limit may be relaxed up to 45 years in the case of a person already in the service of the Punjab Government other State Government, or the Government of India:

Provided further that the Government may for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax the upper age limit for a category or class of persons:

Provided further that in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and other Backward Classes the upper age limit shall be such as may be fixed by the Government from time to time.

- (2) In the case of Demobilized Armed Forces person his age at the time of joining military service or training prior to the commission, as the case may be, should not exceed the upper age limit prescribed for direct appointment to such posts.
- 8. Appointments to the posts in the service shall be made by the Appointing Director.
- 9. (1) Appointments to the posts in the Service shall be made in the Method of manner indicated against each post in Appendix 'B' to these rules.

(2) As soon as a vacancy occurs the appointing authority shall having regard to the percentage fixed in these rules for each method of recruitment, determine the manner in which the same shall be filled.

(3) All promotions within the Service shall be made by Selection based on merit and taking into consideration seniority but seniority alone shall

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master or mistress shall be fixed on the basis of their seniority as a teacher in that district cadre

Probation.

10. (1) Persons appointed to the Service shall remain on probation for a period of two years if recruited by direct appointment and one year if recruited otherwise:

Provided that-

- (a) any period, after such appointment, spent on deputation on a corresponding or a higher post shall count towards the period of
- (b) in the case of appointment by transfer, any period of work in equivalent or higher rank, prior to appointment to the Service may, in the discretion of the appointing authority, be allowed to count towards the period of probation; and
- (c) any period of officiating appointment to the Service shall be reckoned as period spent on probation, but no person who has so officiated shall, on the completion of the prescribed period of probation, be entitled to be confirmed, unless he is appointed against a permanent vacancy.
- (2) If, in the opinion of the appointing authority, the work or conduct of a person during the period of probation is not satisfactory, it may, --
 - (a) if such person is recruited by direct appointment, dispense with
 - (b) if such person is recruited otherwise-
 - (i) revert him to his former post, or
 - (ii) deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of his previous appointment permit.
- (3) On the completion of the period of probation of a person, the appointing authority may,—
 - (a) if his work and conduct has, in its opinion, been satisfactory—
 - (i) confirm such person from the date of his appointment, if appointcd against a permanent vacancy, or
 - (ii) confirm such person from the date from which a permanent vacancy occurs, if appointed against a temporary vacancy or

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(ii) extend his period of probation and thereafter pass such orders as it could have passed on the expiry of the first period of probation:

Provided that the total period of probation, including extension, if any, shall not exceed three years.

11. The seniority in each cadre of the Service shall be determined on Seniority of the basis of continuous length of service on a post in that cadre of the members of service:

Provided that-

- (i) in the case of members recruited by direct appointment the order of merit determined by the Commission, the Board or any other recruiting authority, as the case may be, shall not be disturbed.
- (ii) in the case of two or more members appointed on the same date their seniority shall be determined in the following manner:
 - (a) a member recruited by direct appointment shall be senior to a member recruited otherwise;
 - (b) a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a member appointed by transfer;
 - (c) in the case of members appointed by promotion or transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such members in the appointments from which they were promoted or transferred; and
 - (d) in the case of members appointed by trasfer from different cadres, their seniority shall be determined according to pay, preference being given to a member who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment; and if the rates of pay drawn are also the same, then by their length of service in those appointments; and if, the length of such service is also the same, an older member shall be senior to a younger member.

Note.—Seniority of members appointed on purely provisional basis, shall be determined as and when they are regularly appointed keeping in view the date of such regular appointment.

12. Members of the Service shall be entitled to such scales of pay as pay of may be authorised by Government from time to time. The scales of pay at members of present in force are specified in Appendix 'A' to these rules against each Service.
