3. Vision, Mission and Goals.

a) Vision (Long Term Transformational Objectives) :

To develop the State's human potential through equitable & quality school education to make it productive and useful for the society.

b) Mission (Achievable Tasks Stations):

- Reinforcing the national and integrative character of education to promote a society committed to constitutional values
- To Provide free quality education to all children from Pre-primary to Senior Secondary level.
- To provide assistance to children with special needs for better school education.
- To develop employability in students through vocational education in schools.
- To provide quality teachers, better administration for better learning outcomes.

c) Goals (Measurable Parameters or key Indicators of performance):

- To achieve 100% enrolment of boys and girls at the school level.
- To promote pre-primary education.
- Upgrading and opening of schools, improving infrastructure of schools.
- Enrolling out of school children in regular schools by imparting special training, distribution of free text books and uniforms.
- Providing Inclusive education to special children.
- Providing quality education to the girls by opening girls hostel in educationally backward blocks and minority concentrated blocks.
- Enhancing learning level of students through Parho Punjab and Paraho Punjab Programme.

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- Providing financial support to the students of economically weaker sections of the society to enable them to complete their school education without any kind of hindrance.
- To motivate teachers and school heads for imparting better quality education to the students through trainings.

d) Policy:

Purpose

- To ensure that schools have required physical facilities, staff and supplies at least according to the prescribed standards through financial support in case of Government/ local body, Government Aided Schools and appropriate regulatory mechanism in the case of other schools.
- To ensure that no child is deprived of school education of satisfactory quality due to gender, social-economic, disability and other barriers.
- To provide Vocational Education in selected schools for employable skill development of the interested students.

Content :

- Reading/learning material was provided under Parho Punjab Parhao Punjab Programme to the children of primary classes. Activity based learning material/equipments was provided to the students of upper primary classes.
- Free text books were provided to all eligible students.
- Content was provided for e-libraries established in Govt. High and Senior Secondary Schools.
- Multimedia animated and Computer Aided Learning (CAL) based episode was developed by Punjab Edusat Society for classes VI-XII in various subjects.

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
