

## Annexure - IV

### Minimum qualification of marks in the aptitude test for admission in preferred streams in class XI

1. The students who clear the aptitude test as per clause **2.8**, mentioned under the heading **Admission process**, will be screened for allocating seats in their preferred stream based on the qualifying marks scored in the aptitude test
2. The specified subject to be analyzed for admission in the preferred streams as follows:
  - For admission in commerce, the section for consideration is Math.
  - For admission in science (medical), the section for consideration is Science.
  - For admission in science (non-medical), the section for consideration is Math and Science.
  - For admission in humanities, anyone who qualifies as per clause **2.8** mentioned under the heading **Admission process** will be eligible.
3. For general category, the minimum qualifying marks is 60% and concession of 5% percent in minimum qualifying of marks to reserved category candidates as per the guidelines of the Department of Welfare of Scheduled castes, Backward Class, and Minorities Govt. of Punjab as per the Punjab Scheduled Castes and Backward Castes (Reservation in Services) Act, 2006 (Punjab Act No. 22 of 2006).
4. Reservation criteria mentioned in point no.3 shall also be followed in the stream wise admission i.e for **Commerce (Math section)**, **Science (Medical)**, **Science (Non-Medical)** .
5. For admission in **humanities**, anyone who qualifies as per clause **2.8** mentioned under the heading **Admission process** will be eligible and concession of 5% percent in minimum qualifying of marks to reserved category candidates as per the guidelines of the Department of Welfare of Scheduled castes, Backward Class, and Minorities Govt. of Punjab as per the Punjab Scheduled Castes and Backward Castes (Reservation in Services) Act, 2006 (Punjab Act No. 22 of 2006).
