Aadhaar enrolment of children under 5 years of age is done by capturing only the facial image and demographic attributes. Core biometrics of fingerprints and iris are not captured at this stage. The Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations provide for mandatory biometric update (MBU) upon attaining five years of age and fifteen years of age.

2. Upon attaining the age of five years, the child is required to provide the biometrics of fingerprints and iris for the first time along with an updated facial image. This is commonly known as MBU1. Upon attaining the age of fifteen years, all three biometrics are required to be updated again. This is known as MBU2.

3. It has been observed that there are large number of children between the age of five and fifteen years who have not provided their core biometrics. Hence it can be said that their MBU1 is pending. Similarly, many children have not updated their biometrics after attaining the age of fifteen years and their MBU2 is pending. Due to this, there is a sudden rush for biometric update whenever there is requirement of biometric authentication e.g. appearing in competitive examinations like JEE or NEET etc. In the absence of timely biometric updates, many children are adversely impacted. Therefore, it is important that the MBU1 and MBU2 are done timely.

4. It was thought that a camp approach through the schools could help in completing the pending MBUs. The main question was how the schools would know which students have not done the biometric updates. The technology teams of UIDAI and Department of School Education & Literacy, Govt. of India have worked together to successfully implement a solution through the UDISE+ application. Now all the schools can have visibility of the pending MBUs.

5. May I take this opportunity to request you to kindly issue suitable directions to the Nodal Department for Aadhaar and the School Education Department in your State/UT to conduct targeted MBU camps in the schools in coordination with the UIDAI Regional Offices.
