1.0 I am directed to refer to the judgment dated September 13, 2024, of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP No. 15896 of 2023 - Saurabh Sharma and Ors. Vs. State of Punjab and another. The operative part of the judgement is reproduced as under:-

16. Keeping in view the above, the present petitions are allowed. The respondents are directed to give the petitioners the pay scale which they are entitled under the 2016 Rules from the date of their direct appointment. The petitioners will also be entitled for arrears of salary as they have performed the duties for the post in question from the date of their direct appointment. Let the arrears be calculated and be extended to the petitioners within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

17. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that though the petitioners have claimed interest but keeping in view the fact that they are only interested in the pay scale as entitled to them under 2016 Rules, they are not pressing their claim for the grant of interest.

- 2.0 The said judgment was upheld by the Division Bench in LPA No. 2977 of 2024 and subsequently by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No. 001158 of 2025.
- 3.0 Subsequent to the aforesaid judgment, numerous writ petitions have been filed by employees across various Administrative Departments (ADs) seeking similar relief. The Hon'ble High Court has, from time to time, issued directions in various writ petitions to the concerned

ADs to consider and decide the representations/claims of the petitioners in accordance with the principles laid down in the Saurabh Sharma case,

- 4.0 This Department has received copies of speaking orders, court replies and various other references from various ADs in respect of such cases. Upon examination, it has been observed that:
 - In many instances, the factual matrix of the cases is clearly distinguishable from that in CWP No. 15896 of 2023. Specifically, the pay scales prescribed under the relevant service rules at the time of recruitment are lower than those provided under the notification dated 17,07,2020. Consequently, fixation of pay under the service rules would result in a lower salary for the employees concerned, rendering such cases inapplicable for the relief granted in the Dr. Saurabh Sharma judgment.
- II. It has also come to notice that certain ADs have extended pay scales beyond the scope and intent of the judgment, leading to irregular implementations.
- 5.0 In view of the above and to ensure uniform, lawful, and judicious implementation of the court orders while safeguarding the interests of the State exchequer, the Government hereby issues the following directions to all Administrative Departments:
 - I. Defence of Future Cases and Distinguishable Matters: All ADs shall take immediate steps to properly defend all pending and future court cases where the facts are distinct from those in CWP No. 15896 of 2023. Particular emphasis shall be placed on cases where the pay scales under the notification dated 17.07.2020 are higher than those mentioned in the applicable service rules at the time of recruitment. In such cases, affidavits/replies shall clearly highlight the factual distinctions and argue for non-applicability of the Dr. Saurabh Sharma judgment.
- II. Review of Already Decided Cases: All ADs shall undertake a comprehensive review of all cases already decided or implemented pursuant to directions from the Hon'ble High Court in light of the Dr. Saurabh Sharma judgment. This review shall specifically verify compliance with the instructions issued by this Department dated 03.10.2025.
 - a) In cases where discrepancies are identified (e.g., grant of higher scales contrary to service rules or beyond the judgment's scope), immediate corrective action shall be taken. This includes issuing fresh speaking orders after following due process of law, including providing an opportunity of hearing to the affected employees where required.
 - b) Adjustment of excess payments, if any, shall be initiated in accordance with the Punjab Civil Services Rules and extant government instructions.
 - c) A report on the review findings and actions taken shall be submitted to this Department within 15 days from the date of issuance of these instructions.
- III. Assessment for Clarification, Amendment, or Recall of Orders: During the aforementioned review, ADs shall assess whether there is a need to seek clarification,

amendment, or recall of any court orders in light of these instructions and the factual distinctions observed. If deemed necessary, appropriate applications (e.g., for review, recall, or clarification) shall be filed before the competent court without delay.

6.0 All ADs are directed to nominate a Nodal Officer (not below the rank of Joint Secretary/Deputy Director) to oversee the implementation of these directions and ensure timely compliance. The Nodal Officer shall coordinate with this Department for any clarifications required.
