

PUBLIC NOTICE
DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF CENTRALIZED ONLINE LOTTERY
(Admissions under Section 12(1)(c) of the RTE Act, 2009)
(Academic Session 2026-27)

In continuation of the previous public notices issued by the Department of School Education, Punjab (dated 16.04.2026, 26.04.2026, 07.05.2026, and 18.05.2026) regarding admissions under Section 12(1)(c) of "The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009", following completion of the document verification process, the Centralized Online Draw of Lots (Lottery) for admissions under Section 12(1)(c) of the RTE Act, 2009 has been conducted in a transparent and fair manner, based on the eligibility of applicants, school preferences exercised by them, and neighbourhood mapping criteria and the result for the same has been uploaded on the portal <https://rte.epunjabschool.gov.in>.

Important Directives:

1. All parents and guardians are hereby informed that the Final Results of the Centralized Online Lottery and allotment of seats under the 25% reservation for children belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Disadvantaged Groups (DG) in private unaided recognized schools of Punjab have been declared.
2. Parents/guardians can check their child's selection status and will check their result by visiting the online portal: <https://rte.epunjabschool.gov.in>
3. The concerned school to whom the candidate has been allotted, will verify the result/allotment from their ID on the above portal.
4. Instructions for Selected Students:
 - (a) Parents/Guardians of selected children shall report to the allotted school along with the original supporting documents and the SMS received on their registered mobile number for completion of the admission process.
 - (b) The allotted private unaided recognized schools shall admit the selected children without conducting any screening procedure and without charging any kind of fees, in accordance with the provisions of the RTE Act, 2009.
 - (c) In case of any grievance at the school level, Parents/Guardians may submit a written complaint within one week of action/inaction at the level of concerned school, to the concerned District Education Officer (Elementary), who is the designated Grievance Redressal Officer under the scheme.
 - (d) Selected candidates must produce the required original documents in the allotted school, on or before 20.07.2026, failing which the allotment will liable to be cancelled.
