PUBLIC NOTICE

Punjab Education Development Board

Applications are invited from the eligible Private Partners for Establishment of Adarsh Schools in the State of Punjab under Public Private Partnership Mode as enshrined in the Punjab Education Development Act 1998, at the specified sites .:

Main Features of the Scheme

- i) 10 to 15 Acre of Land will be given free of cost for 99 years on Lease Basis. The Annual Lease will be Rs. 50 per acre per annum.
- ii) The Capital Cost towards construction of Building will be subsidized to the extent of 50% or Rs. 3.75 crores whichever is less.
- iii) The operational cost of an Adarsh Schools with 2000 students with a cap of Rs. 1600 per student shall be shared on 70:30 basis between the Board and the Private Partner, depending upon the level of facilities that the Board and the private partner may mutually agree to provide. The operational cost in respect of students beyond 2000 will be borne wholly by the Private Partner.
- iv) No fee will be charged from the students.
- v) The Adarsh School shall be affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi
- vi) Eligibility Criteria

The criteria for Business Groups/Individuals and Educational Groups is as under:-

The Business Groups/Individuals must have a minimum net worth of Rs. 25.00 Crores This will also include the worth of Charitable Funds, trusts etc., which are run by the Business Group/Individual as the case may be and which separately resolve to support the Adarsh Schools Project.

The Educational groups must have net worth of at least Rs. 5.00 crore.

Business Groups / Individuals and Educational Groups must have a 5 years experience / involvement in the Educational Institutions. Second, the groups must be running at least 2 Educational Institutions (Colleges or Schools) with proper affiliation, with not less than 2000 students for the last 3 years. Charitable Institutions run by these groups would also be counted towards while calculating the numbers of institutions and the numbers of students.

These criteria shall be applicable for a maximum of five schools and thereafter these financial requirements shall be scaled up proportionately in slabs of Rs. 25.00 & 5.00 crore respectively, as the case may be.
